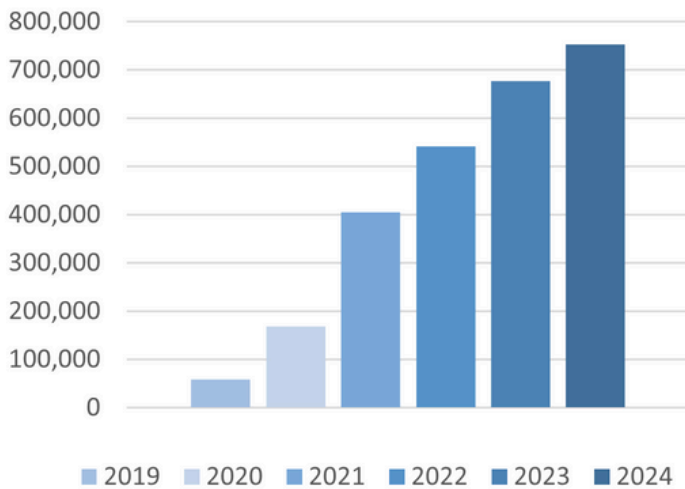

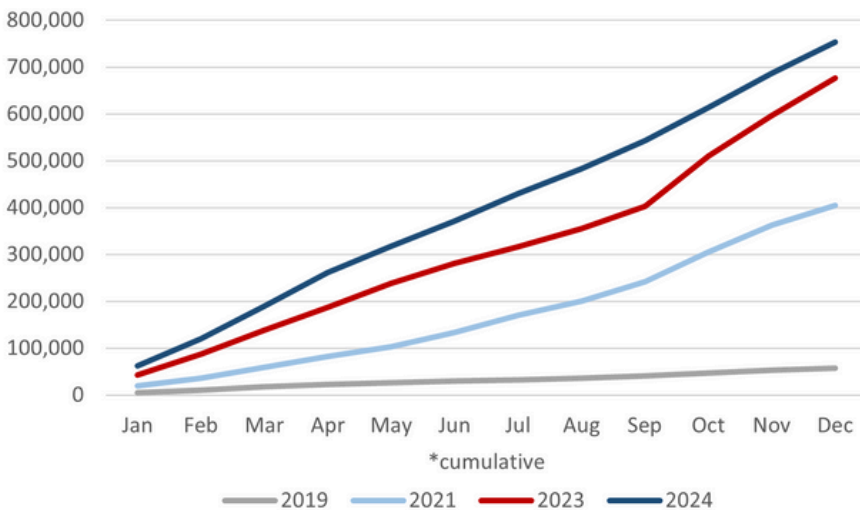
Full Text Views by Year

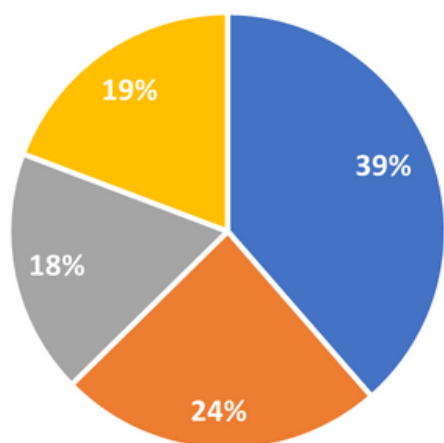

Authors by Region



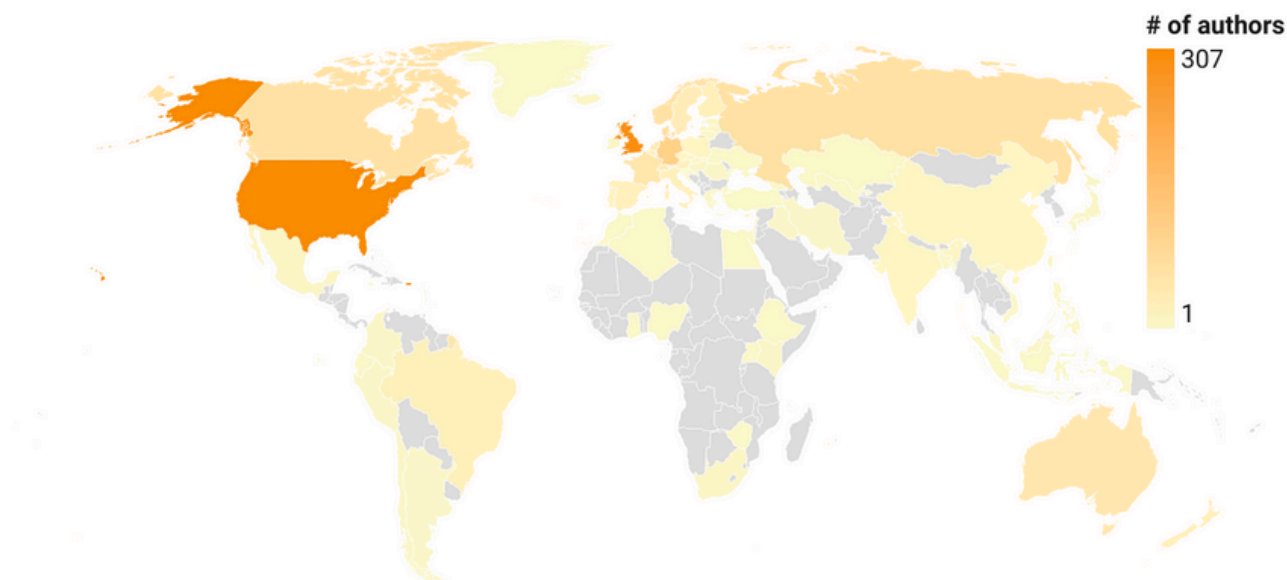

Subscribe-to-open has allowed over 1500 authors from 75 countries to publish open access without APCs and has enabled access to vital anthropology research worldwide.

It has also allowed for titles focusing on niche areas of study to be supported and published open access.
