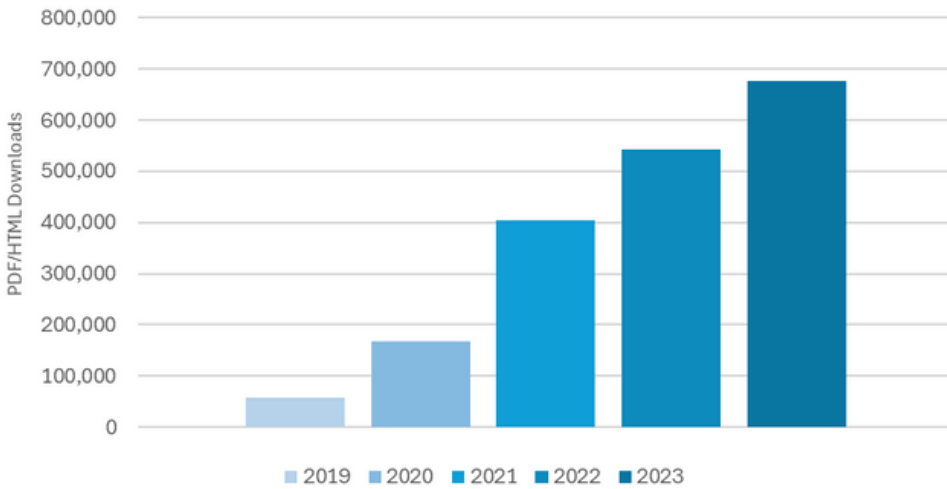

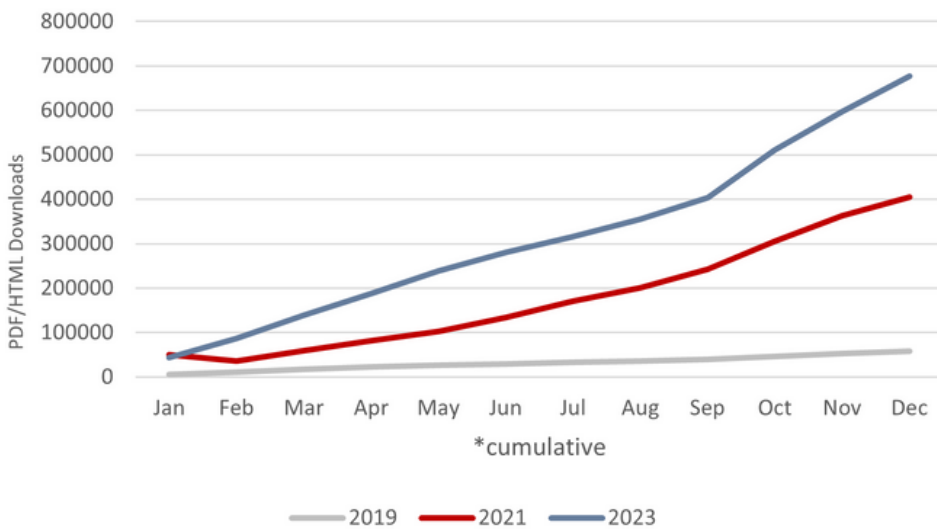
Full Text Views by Year

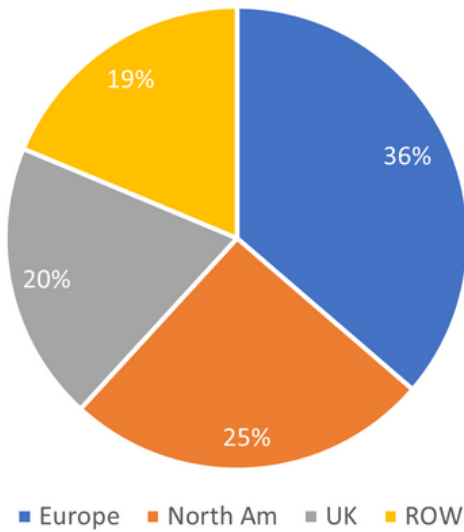

Authors by Region

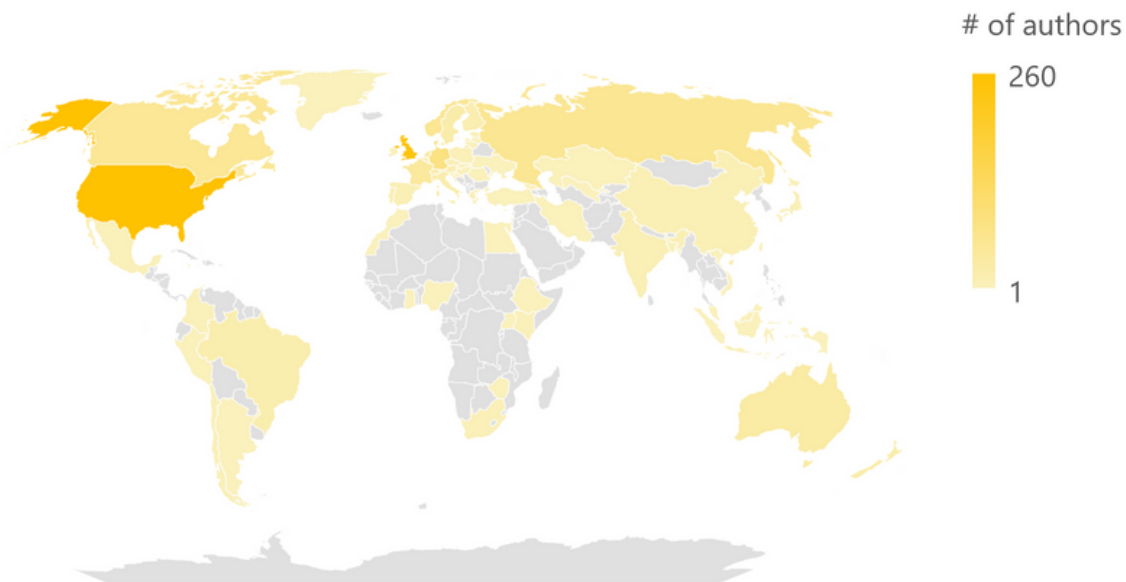


DIVERSITY IN AUTHORSHIP
